Outdoor - This term we will be focussing on basic throwing and catching games. The children will use a range of different equipment to practice and improve their gross motor skills, learning how to aim and become more precise.

Indoor - In gymnastics the children will learn to travel confidently and competently on different parts of their bodies as well as holding and linking different balances.



Home Learning

Your child will be set Home Learning on a Friday and it must be handed in on the following Wednesday. As well as the Home Learning being marked by an adult, the children will be given a list of spellings to practise at home.

Words in the spelling test will include sounds taught in the previous week's phonics as well as 'tricky' and 'high frequency' words.

The children will be given one new reading book on Mondays and Thursdays. Please comment in your child's reading diary that you have read with your child.



Music

This half term Year 1 will be learning about 'Genre' and how music can be created in many different styles. They will be reacting to the music with movement and we will start to discuss emotions and feelings that music can evoke.

This half term our Core Christian Value is 'Koinonia'. After half term it will be 'Friendship'. During our weekly RE lessons we will begin by examining Christianity and the topic, 'Creation'. This will include looking at how people of all religions can use their 'hands' to create, help and care for others. We will link this to the Bible and explore how Jesus cared for those around him. We are of course also very excited about the KS1 Nativity this year!
