Your child will be set English and Maths Home Learning on a Friday and it must be handed in on the following **Wednesday**. As well as the Home Learning being marked by an adult, the children will complete a weekly spelling test in which their application of the spelling pattern taught the week before will be tested. If you require any clarification on tasks set then please do not hesitate to ask.

Your child will also be given a reading record, it is very important that your child reads for at least 10 minutes every night and that this signed record and their book is brought into school every day.

In addition to this, please practise your timetables regularly ensuring children can rapidly recall all facts to 12x12. These facts will be applied constantly during your maths learning.

This term, the class will be playing and performing in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression. They will appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians, developing an understanding of the history of music (A topic on rock music and musical Theory and Glockenspiel).

This half term our Core Christian Value is 'Koinonia'. After half term it will be 'Friendship'. During our weekly RE lessons our unit will focus on answering the question 'What is the best way for a Muslim to show commitment to God (Allah)? We will develop our understanding of this religion and learn the importance of respecting the beliefs of others.
