

P.E.

PE will be taught on a Monday afternoon and Thursday afternoon. This term in outdoor PE the class will focus on different invasion games with our sports coaches. We will look at different passing and shooting techniques as well as tactical aspects like movement off the ball and defensive positioning. In our indoor PE lessons the class will be focusing on dance. As a class we will learn key movements and then children will work

collaboratively in small groups to create their own routine.



Homework

As well as the Home Learning being marked by an adult, the children will complete a weekly spelling test in which their application of the spelling pattern taught the week before will be tested. Your child has also been given a R.A.D Home Reading Record, which they can use to track their reading at home. Please ensure children have a PE kit and reading book with them everyday.

This year the children will be learning the Ukulele! Looking closely at the ukulele, the children will name parts using key vocabulary. They will learn the notes and some chords to help them to play a variety of simple songs. We will have Ukulele on a Monday morning and the school will lend every pupil a Ukulele for the year.
