Start and finish the day promptly
Follow up all absences

Stay with my child (up to Year 5) until school starts in the morning
Let the school know of any issues that may affect my child's welfare or progress

Behaviour

Make sure children understand what is expected of them
Use rewards and sanctions fairly
Set an example of high standards of personal behaviour

Listen to what I am asked to do and do my best to keep to school rules
Show respect to my school, my friends and the adults who help me learn
Take responsibility for my actions

Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour
Help my child understand what is expected at school
Behave in a way that children see as a good example while I am on school premises

Success in Learning

Ensure every child is taught in an appropriate and challenging way
Provide a balanced curriculum
Give regular homework

Do all my class work and homework as well as I can

Discuss with my child's teacher if I have concerns about progress
Allow my child to attend school visits not involving transport
Support my child in homework and out of school activities

Taking part in school life

Keep parents well informed about your child's progress and general school matters
Seek to have strong, productive relationships with parents
Be open and welcoming at all times

Join in as much as I can across school life to help develop my confidence
